

## Twelfth Night Tableaus

1. Twins **Viola** and **Sebastian** wash up separately on the shores of Illyria after a shipwreck. Each one thinks the other has drowned. The **Sea Captain** explains to **Viola** about Illyria and its people.
2. To stay safe in the new land, **Viola** disguises herself as a young man (named **Cesario**) and becomes a servant to **Duke Orsino**, who is in love with the **Lady Olivia**. **Olivia** does not return his love.
3. “**Cesario**” (**Viola**) woos **Olivia** on **Orsino’s** behalf, but she does it unhappily because she has fallen in love with Orsino.

4. **Olivia** falls madly in love with “**Cesario**” (**Viola**), who tries to fend off her advances.

5. Olivia’s uncle, **Sir Toby Belch**, holds nightly parties with **Sir Andrew Aguecheek**, who seeks to marry Olivia but is rebuked by Olivia’s stern Steward, **Malvolio**.

6. **Sir Toby Belch**, **Sir Andrew**, Olivia’s servant **Maria**, and **Feste**, the clown, hide and watch **Malvolio**, reading a love letter they have planted for him - supposedly from **Olivia**.

7. **Viola**’s twin brother, **Sebastian**, arrives in the town and though the siblings do not yet meet, they are inevitably mistaken for each other, with consequences perplexing to them both.

8. **Malvolio** goes to **Olivia** wearing ridiculous yellow stockings and smiling constantly following the instructions in the letter he found, which he believed to be from her. **Malvolio** is thrown into a madhouse.

9. **Olivia** meets and marries Viola's twin brother, **Sebastian**, thinking he is "**Cesario**" (**Viola**).

10. **Viola** and **Sebastian** are reunited, the twin confusion is resolved, and **Orsino** asks **Viola** to marry him!
